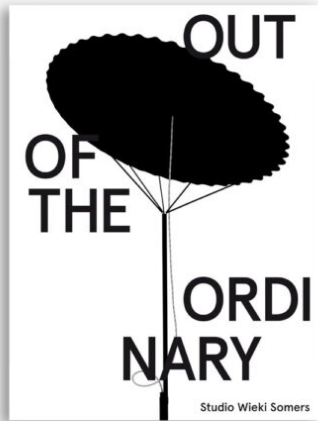


STUDIO WIEKI SOMERS

Established by Wieki Somers and Dylan van den Berg, Studio Wieki Somers sees extraordinary qualities in our everyday surroundings. Their products are remarkable not only for the narratives they contain, but also for their experimental use of materials and technical ingenuity.
