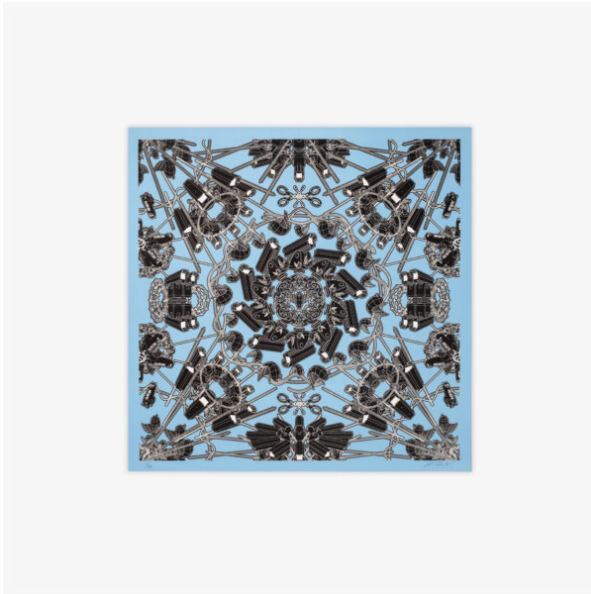

JRP|Editions is proud to introduce a new collaboration with renowned Chinese artist and activist Ai Weiwei, on three series of limited-edition lithographs titled “Grass Mud Horse” - after a mythical animal that has become a tongue-in-cheek icon of resistance to censorship by China’s online communities. The works feature a geometric tile consisting of surveillance cameras, Twitter birds and handcuffs, to symbolise the struggle for freedom of speech.

This project is in partnership with Human Rights Watch, which will benefit from part of the proceeds.
